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AN ACT Concerning the Placement of Railroad  
Lights.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
follows:

23 MRSA §2914-A is enacted to read:

§2914-A. Automatic signals

The department shall construct and maintain auto-  
matic signals employing flashing lights which give  
warning of the approach of a train at all heavily  
traveled railroad crossings as determined by the de-  
partment.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

2           The purpose of this bill is to require the De-  
3           partment of Transportation to construct and maintain  
4           automatic crossing signals at all heavily traveled  
5           railroad crossings.

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
