17 AN ACT Concerning Passengers Riding in  
18 Open-body Trucks.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
21 follows:

22 29 MRSA §1000 is enacted to read:

23 §1000. Passengers in trucks

24 No person may operate a truck on a public way  
25 with any passenger in or on any portion of the vehi-  
26 cle which is not enclosed or which is not designed  
27 for passenger occupancy. As used in this section,  
28 "truck" means a motor vehicle designed or used prin-  
29 cipally for carrying things other than passengers and  
30 includes a motor vehicle to which has been added a  
31 cabinet box, platform, racks or other equipment for  
32 the purpose of carrying materials other than passen-  
33 gers or their effects.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to prohibit persons  
3 from riding in open-bodied trucks.

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
