18 Mirrors that Distort the Actual Image.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 29 MRSA §1367-B is enacted:

23 §1367-B. Use of certain rearview mirrors prohibited

24 No person may operate upon any public way any mo-
25 tor vehicle equipped with any rearview mirror
26 externally mounted on the passenger side of the vehi-
27 cle, the entire surface of which provides the opera-
28 tor with a deliberately distorted reflected image.
