Amend the bill in section 2 by striking out every erything after the amending clause and inserting in its place the following:
'3. Private school activity bus. The term "private school activity bus" means a privately-owned most tor vehicle with a carrying capacity of 10 to 15 passengers, which is not paid for in part or in whole with public funds and which is used by a private school, as defined in Title 20-A, section 1, subsection 22, to transport its students other than to and from home and school.'
21 STATEMENT OF FACT
This amendment corrects an error in drafting of the original bill. It makes clear that the new category of private school activity bus applies only to vehicles with a carrying capacity of 10 to 15 passengers, and it exempts vehicles with a capacity of fewer than 10 passengers from the definition of school bus.
