SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 643, L.D. 897,  
8 Bill, "AN ACT to Deny Certain State Funds to Any Per-  
9 son Who Refuses to Register Under the United States  
10 Military Selective Services Act."

11

Amend the Bill in that part designated "§12601."  
12 by striking out all of the last 2 paragraphs and in-  
13 serting in their place the following:

14

'Any person who is required to present himself  
15 and submit to registration under the United States  
16 Military Selective Services Act, 50 United States  
17 Code, -App., Section 451, et seq., and who fails to  
18 do so is ineligible to enroll in post-secondary edu-  
19 cational programs.

20

The officials who administer post-secondary edu-  
21 cational programs shall require all applicants to  
22 submit written proof of registration prior to enroll-  
23 ment.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

25

This amendment prevents persons who have not com-  
26 plied with the federal draft registration law from  
27 enrolling in post-secondary educational programs.
