19 Person Who Refuses to Register Under
20 the United States Military Selective
21 Services Act.

23 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
24 follows:

25 20-A MRSA c. 429 is enacted to read:

26 CHAPTER 429

27 PERSONS FAILING TO REGISTER UNDER UNITED STATES

28 MILITARY SELECTIVE SERVICES ACT

29 §12601. Disqualification for state financial assist-
30 ance

31 Any person who is required to present himself and
32 submit to registration under the United States Mili-

1 tary Selective Services Act, 50 United States Code,
2 -App., Section 451, et seq., and who fails to do so
3 is ineligible to receive any state funded grant,
4 scholarship or loan made available to persons en-
5 rolled in post-secondary educational programs.

6 The officials who administer those financial as-
7 sistance programs may require an applicant to submit
8 written proof of registration prior to the award of a
9 post-secondary educational grant, loan or scholar-
10 ship.

11 STATEMENT OF FACT

12 This new draft prevents persons who have not com-
13 plied with the federal draft registration law from
14 receiving any state funded scholarship, loan or
15 grant.
