COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 335, L.D. 898, Bill, "AN ACT to Make Supplemental Allocations to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1986, and June 30, 1987."
Amend the bill by striking out all of section l and inserting in its place the following:
'Sec. 1. Supplemental allocation of Inland Fish- eries and Wildlife funds. Income to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife for the next 2 fiscal years, from July 1, 1985, to June 30, 1986, and from July 1, 1986, to June 30, 1987, shall be segregated, apportioned and disbursed as designated in the fol- lowing schedule.
