11 12 13 14 15 16	No food containing surimi or a surimi product may be served in any eating establishment in the State whether for consumption on or off the premises, un- less the menu and all notices advertising that food conspicuously indicates that surimi or a surimi product was used in the food.

STATEMENT OF FACT

22 Surimi is a seafood product processed in such a 23 manner as to either appear or taste as a different 24 seafood product. This bill requires that all 25 products containing surimi be labeled as such.
