23 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-  
24 lature do not become effective until 90 days after  
25 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

26 Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate un-  
27 til after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

28 Whereas, certain obligations and expenses will  
29 become due and payable prior to June 30, 1985; and

30 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,  
31 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of  
32 the Constitution of Maine and require the following  
33 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-  
34 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,  
35 therefore,

1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
2 follows:

3 Additional allocation of Inland Fisheries and  
4 Wildlife funds. Income to the Inland Fisheries and  
5 Wildlife funds for the fiscal year from July 1, 1984,  
6 to June 30, 1985, shall be segregated, apportioned  
7 and disbursed as designated in the following sched-  
8 ule.
