## STATEMENT OF FACT

6 The purpose of this bill is to amend the law 7 dealing with burial of persons eligible for municipal 8 assistance to provide that funeral directors need not 9 give notice to the overseer prior to making burial 10 preparations when circumstances prevent that notice.

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
