HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A"
to H.P. 644, L.D. 914, "RESOLVE, Creating a Special
Commission to Study Teacher Training in the Universi-
ty of Maine System."

Amend the Amendment by inserting after the 4th
paragraph after the title the following:

'Further amend the resolve by striking out all of
the 11th paragraph after the title and inserting in
its place the following:

Reimbursement. Resolved: That members of the com-
mission shall not be paid per diem. Members of the
commission who are Legislators shall be reimbursed
for expenses as provided in the Maine Revised Stat-
utes, Title 3, section 2. Members of the commission
who are not Legislators shall be reimbursed for ex-
penses in accordance with the Maine Revised Statutes,
Title 5, chapter 379; and be it further

Further amend the resolve by striking out all of
the 3rd paragraph before the Statement of Fact (page
4, lines 37 and 38 and page 5, lines 1 and 2 in
L.D.)'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment makes 2 technical changes. One
change subjects members of the commission who are not
Legislators to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5,
chapter 379, which governs compensation and expenses
of members of boards and commissions.

The 2nd change removes the funding section of the
