15	STATEMENT OF FACT
16 17 18 19 20 21 22 23 24 25 26 27 28	The purpose of this amendment is to remove the emergency preamble and emergency clause from the resolve. Two other study groups are conducting limited reviews of the teacher training program at the university and will report their findings late this year. These narrow, focused studies may be useful to the commission created by this bill in carrying out its comprehensive study. Since this commission will not report its findings until January 1987 and since the other study groups will report later this year, there are advantages to the commission established in this bill not starting its work immediately. The emergency provisions are not necessary.
