HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 646, L.D. 916,
Bill, "AN ACT to Regulate Fishing Derbies."

Amend the bill by inserting after the enacting
clause the following:

'Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7001, sub-§8-A is enacted to
read:

8-A. Fishing derby. "Fishing derby" means an
organized fishing event conducted on inland waters
during which contestants compete for cash awards or
other prizes.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the begin-
ning of the first line after the enacting clause the
following: 'Sec. 2.'
