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7. Dismissal of complaint. If the plaintiff de-termines that an interim order issued by the court, 1 2 3 pursuant to section 765, subsection 4, is no longer necessary, the plaintiff must appear at the full hearing scheduled pursuant to section 765, subsection 4 5 б 1. The plaintiff shall at that time make an oral motion to dismiss and provide the court with reasons 7 for the request to dismiss the order. Failure of the 8 plaintiff to appear as required by this subsection 9 shall result in the consequences provided for in sec-10 11 tion 764.

13 The purpose of this bill is to provide incentive 14 to a plaintiff in an action for protection from abuse 15 to appear at the hearing to determine whether an or-16 der should be issued.

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
