17 AN ACT Pertaining to the Terms of Members of
18 Transit District Boards.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 30 MRSA §4972, last ¶, as enacted by PL 1983, c.
23 36, is amended to read:

24 Notwithstanding this section, the board of direc-
25 tors of the Greater Portland Transit District, pres-
26 ently comprised of the Cities of Portland and
27 Westbrook, shall consist of 5 directors appointed
28 from the City of Portland and 3 directors appointed
29 from the City of Westbrook. The Cities of Portland
30 and Westbrook may, by ordinance, provide that their
31 appointees serve at the pleasure of the appointing
32 power or for terms which are shorter than those es-
33 tablished in this section.

STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this bill is to permit the Cities
3 of Portland and Westbrook to appoint representatives
4 for less than the 3-year terms provided.

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
