Maine's black bear population is considerably larger than it was estimated to be during the mid-1970's. Recent studies conducted by the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife together with a substantial increase in bear damage complaints, indicate that the black bear population is expanding beyond acceptable levels.

The purpose of this bill is to provide the commissioner with the flexibility to open the bear hunting season one month earlier than the current law allows. Increasing the season framework will provide annual opportunity for a longer hunting season as necessary to keep black bear populations at optimum levels.
