- State, appointed by the Governor. The committee 1 2 shall select from among its members a chairman.
 - §102. Term; meetings; compensation
- 4 1. Term. The 4 members appointed by the Gover-5 nor shall serve for a term of 3 years; except that of 6 those first appointed, 2 shall be appointed for a 7 term of 2 years and 2 shall be appointed for a term 8 of 3 years. All other members shall serve during 9 their tenure in the position which they represent on the committee. Vacancies on the committee shall be 10 filled in the same manner as the original appointment 11
- 12 for the remainder of the unexpired term.
- 13 2. Meetings. Meetings shall be held as necessary to conduct the business of the committee and may 14 be convened at the call of the chairman or a majority 15 16 of the committee members. Four members of the com-17 mittee shall constitute a quorum.
- 3. Compensation. Members shall be compensated 18 19 according to the provisions of Title 5, chapter 379.

- The committee shall have the following duties. 21
- 1. Selection of judicial nominees. When a va-22 cancy occurs, a new position is created or a term expires for any Supreme Judicial Court Justice, Justice 23 24 of the Superior Court, District Court Judge, Adminis-25 trative Court Judge or Associate Administrative Court 26 Judge, the committee shall select at least 3 individ-27 uals who, in the opinion of the committee, are quali-28 29 fied to fill that position.
- 2. Submission to Governor. The committee shall 30 submit a list of the names of individuals recommended 31 32 for each position pursuant to subsection 1 to the 33 Governor.
- 34 §104. Nomination by Governor
- The Governor shall nominate an individual for a 35 judicial position from among those names submitted to 36 37 him by the committee pursuant to section 103. If the
