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## STATEMENT OF FACT

3 The purpose of this new draft is to clarify that 4 municipalities have home rule authority to establish 5 the alternate licensing procedure set out in this new 6 draft. The new draft clarifies that a municipality 7 may establish its town or city council or board of selectmen as the licensing 8 authority. Licenses 9 granted under this alternate procedure will expire 10 one year from the date of issuance, not automatically on the last day of May as is currently the law. 11

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
