HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 677, L.D. 939,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Weir Licensing Law."

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§1023." in the first paragraph in the next to the last line (page 2, line 16 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words "and operated"

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§1023." in the 2nd paragraph in the first and 2nd lines (page 2, lines 18 and 19 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words "and operated"

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§1023." by inserting after subsection 3 the following:

'Satisfaction of these conditions shall be necessary but not sufficient to retain the weir's protected fishing zone as provided by Title 12, section 6525-A, subsections 1 and 5.'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§1023." in the 3rd paragraph in the next to the last line (page 2, line 37 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words "and operated"

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is clarify the application of weir licensing provisions to the fishing limitations provided in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 12. It is the intent of this amendment that a weir which has been properly maintained and licensed but which is not "in operating condition," i.e., ful-
