21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 12 MRSA §7455, sub-§2 is enacted to read:

24 2. Spruce grouse. During any open season on
25 hunting ruffed grouse, a person may take one spruce
26 grouse which shall be included in the daily bag limit
27 on ruffed grouse as established by the commissioner.
