Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated "<u>§5437.</u>" in subsection 3, by striking out all of paragraphs D, E and F (page 2, lines 23 to 29 in L.D.)

Further amend the bill in section 2, in that part designated "<u>§5437.</u>" in subsection 4 by adding at the end the following:

28 'No disbursement may be made unless evidence is provided that the expense is not reimbursable by the 30 Medicaid Program. It is the intent of the Legislature that the contingency fund established in this 32 section be the funding source of last resort.'

33 Further amend the bill by striking out all of 34 section 3 and inserting in its place the following:
