- 4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
 - Sec. 1. Validating the vote to convert Wallagrass Plantation the Town into Wallagrass. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the results of the vote, at the election on November 6, 1984, of the legal voters within the territory embraced within the limits of the proposed Town of Wallagrass, whereby the legal voters voted to convert Wallagrass Plantation to the Town of Wallagrass, are validated, confirmed and made effective.
 - Sec. 2. Certificate to Secretary of State. Upon certification to the Secretary of State by the plantation clerk that a majority of legal voters of Wallagrass Plantation voted affirmatively on November 6, 1984, that Wallagrass Plantation be incorporated into the Town of Wallagrass, including an attested copy of the question voted and yes and no votes cast, this vote shall be declared approved, provided further that the total number of votes cast for and against the measure equaled or exceeded 50% of the total number of votes cast in the plantation for Governor at the last gubernatorial election.
 - Sec. 3. Effective date. Section 2 of this Act shall take effect upon proper certification to the Secretary of State and shall take effect for all purposes at the first town meeting.
- 31 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited 32 in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.
