22 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
23 lature do not become effective until 90 days after
24 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

25 Whereas, prompt determination and certification
26 of the municipal cost components in the Unorganized
27 Territory Tax District is necessary to the establish-
28 ment of a mill rate and the levy of the unorganized
29 territory educational and services tax; and

30 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
31 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
32 the Constitution of Maine and require the following
33 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
34 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
35 therefore,

1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
2 follows:

3 **Municipal cost components for services ren-**
4 **dered.** In accordance with the Maine Revised Stat-
5 **utes, Title 36, chapter 115, the Legislature deter-**
6 **mines that the net municipal cost component for ser-**
7 **vices and reimbursements to be rendered in fiscal**
8 **year 1985-86 is \$5,885,768.89 as reflected in the**
9 **following list.**
