22 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
23 follows:

24 36 MRSA §6108, as amended by PL 1981, c. 698,
25 §189, is further amended to read:

26 §6108. Income limitation

27 No claim otherwise allowable may be granted to
28 claimants of single member households with household
29 income in excess of \$5,600 in calendar year 1980 and
30 ~~\$6,200~~ \$7,000 in each succeeding year for which re-
31 lief is requested; and no claim otherwise allowable
32 may be granted to claimants of households of 2 or more
33 members with income in excess of \$6,700 in calendar
34 year 1980 and ~~\$7,400~~ \$8,300 in each succeeding year
35 for which relief is requested.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this bill is to raise the income
3 limitations under the Elderly Householders Tax and
4 Rent Refund Act and the Elderly Low Cost Drug Program
5 by approximately 12%.

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
