20 21	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:					
22 23	7 MRSA §3455, first ¶, as amended by PL 1979, c. 541, Pt. A, §76, is further amended to read:					
24 25 26 27 28	It shall be unlawful for any dog, licensed or unlicensed, to run at large, except when used for hunting. The owner of any dog running-at-large commits a civil violation for which a forfeiture of not less than \$25 nor more than \$100 shall be adjudged.					

1	STATEMENT	OF	FACT	

This new draft clarifies the intent of the original bill by making the owner of the dog responsible for a dog running-at-large and by stipulating a pen-alty.
