7 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 355, L.D. 963,
8 "Resolve, Establishing the Maine Commission on the
9 Role of State Government in Providing Independent
10 Living Opportunities and Services to Disabled Per-
11 sons."

12 Amend the resolve in subsection 2 in the last
13 line (page 2, line 7 in L.D.) by striking out the
14 word "and"

15 Further amend the resolve in subsection 3 in the
16 last line (page 2, line 13 in L.D.) by striking out
17 the words "be it further"

18 Further amend the resolve by inserting after sub-
19 section 3 the following:

20 '4. How the various roles of State Government,
21 private rehabilitation service agencies and client
22 advocacy groups can be defined, enhanced and modified
23 to provide the most appropriate service without du-
24 plication or conflict and to develop a true partner-
25 ship; and be it further'

26 Further amend the resolve in the 4th paragraph
27 from the end in the 10th and 11th lines (page 2,
28 lines 42 and 43 in L.D.) by striking out the follow-
29 ing: "First Regular Session of the 113th" and insert-
30 ing in its place the following: 'Second Regular Ses-
31 sion of the 112th'

32 Further amend the resolve in the last paragraph
33 in the first line (page 3, line 14 in L.D.) by strik-
34 ing out the following: "\$50,000" and inserting in its
35 place the following: '\$17,700'
