13 14 15	'13-A MRSA §716, as enacted by PL 1971, c. 439, $\S1$, is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:
16 17 18 19 20 21 22	In discharging their duties, the directors and officers may, in considering the best interests of the corporation and of its shareholders, consider the effects of any action upon employees, suppliers and customers of the corporation, communities in which offices or other establishments of the corporation are located and all other pertinent factors.
23	STATEMENT OF FACT
24 25 26 27	This amendment adds a provision to the section in the Maine Business Corporation Act that describes the duties of the directors and officers of a corporation.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " $oldsymbol{\beta}$ " to H.P. 678, L.D. 965

Current law requires the directors and officers to exercise their powers and discharge their duties with a view to the interests of the corporation and the shareholders. When doing so, this amendment allows them to consider the effects of corporate decisions upon employees, suppliers and customers of the corporation, as well as communities in which the corporation may be located.
