17 AN ACT to Redefine the Southern Boundary to  
18 Enlarge the Moose Hunting District.  
19

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
21 follows:

22 12 MRSA §7463-A, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1981,  
23 c. 118, §2, is amended to read:

24 1. Moose hunting district. A moose hunting dis-  
25 trict is established in that area of the State north  
26 of the Canadian Pacific Railroad mainline running  
27 from Vanceboro, through Brownville to the Canadian  
28 border Route 16 from Wilson's Mills east across the  
29 State to the intersection of Route 6 at Milo, then  
30 east along Route 6 to Vanceboro, except for those ar-  
31 reas of the State closed to hunting described in chap-  
32 ter 713, subchapter I.
