22 23 24	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis- lature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
25 26 27 28 29	Whereas, the provision of the social worker registration law exempting employees of nursing homes from requirements of licensing or supervision under that law will expire on July 1, 1985, if this legislation is not enacted; and
30 31 32 33 34 35	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

1 2	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3 4	<pre>32 MRSA §7003, sub-§3, as amended by PL 1983, c. 263, is further amended to read:</pre>
5 6 7 8 9	3. Employment by a nursing home. The person is employed by a nursing home licensed under Title 22, section 1811, and that person is engaging in the independent practice of social work on behalf of a nursing home. This exemption expires on July 1, \frac{1}{2985} \frac{1}{2987}.
11 12 13	Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.
14	STATEMENT OF FACT
15 16 17	This bill extends for 2 years the sunset provision which exempts nursing homes from the requirements of social worker registration.
