17 AN ACT Relating to the Selection of Counters
18 under the Election Laws.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 21 MRSA §532, sub-§2, ¶D, as enacted by PL 1967,
23 c. 225, §6, is amended to read:

24 D. Counters. The clerk may appoint a sufficient
25 number of election clerks, an equal number from
26 each political party, who are nominated as pro-
27 vided in subsection 1, to serve as counters at
28 the close of polls who shall be paid a reasonable
29 compensation as determined by the municipal offi-
30 cers.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to provide that election clerks to act as counters shall be chosen in the same manner as election clerks and alternate clerks.

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
