1 A. The commissioner may reduce or waive the min-2 imum number of days required on application from 3 a school board. The application must be sup-4 ported in writing with a statement of the reasons 5 for the request.

6 Notwithstanding any other section в. of the 7 statutes, school committees, with the approval of 8 the commissioner, may adopt or amend rules necessary to implement an extended school year at the 9 10 local level. The commissioner may make appropri-11 ate adjustments, not to exceed the allowable subsidy, to insure fair and equitable treatment in 12 13 the distribution of state aid.

14Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall take ef-15fect July 1, 1986.

STATEMENT OF FACT

17 The school year for students is now interrupted by up to 10 half days for teacher workshops and cur-riculum planning. This bill requires school systems 18 19 20 to hold workshops and carry out planning before or 21 after the start of the student school year, during Christmas, spring or winter breaks, evenings 22 or 23 weekends. This will not interfere with the vacation 24 period traditionally granted for the potato harvest.
