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20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
21 follows:

22 30 MRSA §4972, last ¶, as enacted by PL 1983, c.  
23 36, is amended to read:

24 Notwithstanding this section, the board of direc-  
25 tors of the Greater Portland Transit District, pres-  
26 ently comprised of the Cities of Portland and  
27 Westbrook, shall consist of 5 directors appointed  
28 from the City of Portland and 3 directors appointed  
29 from the City of Westbrook and action by a majority  
30 of those present at any meeting at which a quorum is  
31 in attendance shall be deemed to be the action of the  
32 full board of directors.

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The purpose of this bill is to provide for majority rule on the Board of the Greater Portland Transit District.

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
