COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 375, L.D. 1009, Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize Sagadahoc County to Raise Funds to Renovate and Expand the Present Court Facilities at Bath."

Amend the Bill in the title in the last line (page 1, line 19 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Court Facilities" and inserting in its place the following: 'Courthouse'

Further amend the Bill in section 1 in the first line (page 1, line 23 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "court facility" and inserting in its place the following: 'courthouse' and in the last line (page 1, line 28 in L.D.) by striking out the words "court facilities" and inserting in their place the word 'courthouse'

Further amend the Bill in section 3 in the 2nd line (page 2, line 2 in L.D.) by striking out the words "court facilities" and inserting in their place the word 'courthouse'

Further amend the Bill by inserting after section 5 the following:

'Sec. 6. Funds not expended. If any proceeds from the sale of the bonds have not been expended within 10 years ater the date of sale, those proceeds shall lapse to the county's debt service account.'

Further amend the Bill in section 6 in the 2nd paragraph, 4th line (page 3, line 8 in L.D.) by inserting after the word "question" the following: 'with the accompanying statement concerning estimated debt service'
