COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 703, L.D. 1013, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Retirement Options for Legislators."

Amend the bill in section 1, in that part designated "§703." by striking out all of the first line (page 4, line 10 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following: '§703. Exemption from execution'

Further amend the bill in section 1, in that part designated "§802." in subsection 1, in the 4th and 5th lines (page 9, lines 30 and 31 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words "without contribution by the member"

Further amend the bill by inserting before the emergency clause the following:

'Sec. 5. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this bill.
