7 HOUSE AMENDMENT " \mathcal{A} " to H.P. 703, L.D. 1013, 8 Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Retirement Options for Legislators."

Amend the bill in section 1, in that part designated "§701." by striking out all of subsection 3 and inserting in its place the following:

- '3. Average final compensation. "Average final compensation" means the average annual rate of earnable compensation of a member during the 3 years of creditable service, not necessarily consecutive, as a Legislator in which the average annual rate of earnable compensation is highest or during his entire period of creditable service if the period is less than 3 years."
- Further amend the bill in section 1, in that part designated "§801." in subsection 1, in the 15th line (page 9, line 9 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined word "may" and inserting in its place the following: $\frac{1}{2}$

Further amend the bill in section 1, in that part designated "§851." in subsection 2, in the 3rd line (page 13, line 20 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "birthday." the following: 'Creditable service as a member of the Maine State Retirement System after service as a member of the Maine Legislative Retirement System shall be used in determining the completion of 25 years of creditable service.'

- Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 4 and inserting in its place the following:

HOUSE AMENDMENT " θ " to H.P. 703, L.D. 1013

1	3. Creditable service of 25 years. Any member
2	who has completed 25 or more years of creditable ser-
3	vice may retire any time prior to the attainment of
4	age 60 and receive a service retirement allowance
5	upon written application to the board of trustees
6	setting forth at what time he desires to be retired.
7	Creditable service as a member of the Maine Legisla-
8	tive Retirement System before becoming a member of
9	the Maine State Retirement System shall be used in
10	determining the completion of 25 years of creditable
11	service. The retirement allowance shall be determined
12	in accordance with subsection 2, paragraph A, but
13	shall be at a reduced amount determined by applying
14	to the retirement allowance the percentage that a
15	life annuity due at age 60 bears to the life annuity
16	due at the age of retirement, subject to subsection
17	4. For this purpose the tables of annuities as ap-
18	proved by the board of trustees at the date of re-
19	tirement shall be used.'

20 STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment provides a mechanism for computing retirement benefits for legislative service separate from the retirement benefits associated with state service.
