Creditable service as a member of the Maine Legislative Retirement System before becoming a member of the Maine State Retirement System shall be used in determining the completion of 10 years of creditable service. Any member not in service may retire at the age of 60 years or thereafter on a service retirement allowance upon written application to the board of
