Amend the bill in section 1 in that part design-
nated "§851." in subsection 1 by inserting in the
last line (page 13, line 17 in L.D.) the following
underlined sentence: 'Creditable service as a member
of the Maine State Retirement System after service as
a member of the Maine Legislative Retirement System
shall be used in determining the completion of 10
years of creditable service.'

A. Any member, who at the attainment of age 60
years is in service, may retire at any time then
or thereafter on a service retirement allowance,
provided that the member has been in service for
a minimum of one year immediately prior to re-
tirement or has at least 10 years of creditable
service, upon written application to the board of
trustees setting forth at what time he desires to
be retired. Creditable service as a member of
the Maine Legislative Retirement System before
becoming a member of the Maine State Retirement
System shall be used in determining the comple-
tion of 10 years of creditable service. Any mem-
ber not in service may retire at the age of 60
years or thereafter on a service retirement al-
lowance upon written application to the board of
trustees setting forth at what time he desires to
