17 AN ACT to Require All Restaurants to Provide  
18 Rest Rooms for their Patrons.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
21 follows:

22 §2502 MRSA §2502 is enacted to read:

23 §2502. Rest rooms

24 Any eating establishment serving food or drink to  
25 the public for consumption on the premises shall pro-  
26 vide a minimum of 2 rest rooms for the use of the pa-  
27 trons of that establishment. These rest rooms shall  
28 be clearly marked and maintained in a sanitary condi-  
29 tion and good repair. There shall be no charge for  
30 the use of the rest rooms.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

2           The purpose of this bill is to require that all  
3 eating establishments serving food or drink for on-  
4 premise consumption provide rest room facilities for  
5 their patrons.

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
