- 4 3. Students. "Students" means any individual between the age of 5 and 21 years, who is otherwise entitled to a public education in the State.
- 7 §9602. Establishment of educational component

A school administrative unit and a long-term drug treatment center may apply to the Department of Educational and Cultural Services for approval to institute and offer an educational program. Approval shall be based upon consideration of the following criteria:

- 1. Plan. Submission of a plan by a school administrative unit in conjunction with a long-term treatment center to operate the educational program;
- 2. Compliance with requirements. Proof of compliance of the plan with the requirements of Title 22, section 7801, and any rules promulgated under that section;
- 21 3. Accounting. An accounting of all students 22 who will be provided for under that plan; and
 - 4. Line-item budget. Submission of a line-item budget by no later than 90 days prior to the annual period for which funding is being requested. In no event may the proposed budget request exceed on a per student basis the local school administrative unit tuition rate as provided for in section 5805.

The long-term treatment center may petition the commissioner for resolution of the disagreement if a treatment center and a school administrative unit cannot reach agreement on a plan. The resolution shall be completed within 60 days of the filing of a petition.
