HOUSE AMENDMENT "*A*" to H.P. 733, L.D. 1042,  
Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Management and Conser-  
vation of the Lobster Resource."

Amend the bill in section 2, in that part desig-  
nated "§6422." in subsection 2, paragraph B, in the  
2nd line (page 3, line 5 in L.D.) by striking out the  
underlined words and punctuation "C, Class D or Class  
X" and inserting in their place the underlined words  
'C or Class D'

Further amend the bill in section 2, in that part  
designated "§6422." in subsection 5, paragraph A,  
subparagraph (1) by striking out the underlined word  
"state" and inserting in its place the underlined  
word 'Maine'

Further amend the bill in section 2, in that part  
designated "§6422." by striking out all of subsection  
10 (page 8, lines 6 to 20 in L.D.)

Further amend the bill in section 2, in that part  
designated "§6422." in subsection 12, paragraph B, by  
striking out all of subparagraph (6), (page 9, line  
22 in L.D.)

Further amend the bill in section 2, in that part  
designated "§6422." in subsection 12 by striking out  
all of paragraph E and inserting in its place the  
following:

'E. The fees for trap tags shall be as follows:

(1) For a Class A or Class B boat license,  
the trap tag fee shall be 50¢ each; and

(2) For a Class C or Class D boat license,

1                   the trap tag fee shall be 50¢ each.'

2                   Further amend the bill in section 2, in that part  
3 designated "§6422." in subsection 12, paragraph F, in  
4 the 2nd line (page 10, line 9 in L.D.) by striking  
5 out the underlined words "allocated to the Enforce-  
6 ment Fund" and inserting in their place the under-  
7 lined words 'allocated, in equal amounts, to the En-  
8 forcement Fund and the Hatchery Fund'

9                   Further amend the bill in section 2, in that part  
10 designated "§6422." by striking out all of subsec-  
11 tions 14 and 15 (page 10, lines 24 to 37 and page 11,  
12 lines 1 to 22 in L.D.)

13                   Further amend the bill in section 2, in that part  
14 designated "§6422." by renumbering the subsections to  
15 read consecutively.

16                   Further amend the bill by striking out all of  
17 sections 3 to 6, 12 and 13.

18                   Further amend the bill in section 14, in that  
19 part designated "§6453." in subsection 1, in the 2nd  
20 and 3rd lines (page 15, lines 2 and 3 in L.D.) by  
21 striking out the underlined words "enforcement of"  
22 and inserting in their place the underlined words  
23 'enforcement and administration of'

24                   Further amend the bill in section 14, by striking  
25 out all of that part designated "§6455."

26                   Further amend the bill by striking out all of  
27 sections 15 to 20.

28                   Further amend the bill by renumbering the sec-  
29 tions to read consecutively.

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 733, L.D. 1042

1 STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this amendment is to remove the  
3 provisions of the bill dealing with:

4 1. The harvesting of lobsters larger than 5  
5 inches;

6 2. Class X boat licenses; and

7 3. Revenues from lobster licenses.

8 The amendment also provides that fees from trap  
9 tags shall be allocated equally to the Enforcement  
10 Fund and the Hatchery Fund.
