Program and Adjust the Real Estate Transfer Tax." 10 11 Amend the bill by striking out all of the emer-12 gency preamble. 13 Further amend the bill in section 2 by striking 14 out everything after the amending clause and insert-15 ing in its place the following: 16 'The State Tax Assessor shall pay all net receipts to the Treasurer of State, who shall credit 1/2 of the revenue to the General Fund and who shall 17 18 monthly pay the remaining 1/2 to the Maine State Housing Authority, which shall deposit the funds in 19 20 21 the Housing Opportunities for Maine Fund created in 22 Title 30, section 4733. 23 Further amend the bill by inserting after section 24 2 the following: 25 'Sec. 3. 36 MRSA §4641-N is enacted to read: 26 §4641-N. Review 27 The Maine State Housing Authority shall submit a 28 report to the joint standing committee of the Legis-29 lature having jurisdiction over taxation by April 1, 1987, and each 2 years thereafter. The report shall cover the 2 prior fiscal years of the authority and 30 31 32 shall identify the amount of revenues under this 33 chapter that have been credited to the Housing Opportunities for Maine Fund and the manner in which those 34 35 funds have been used. The committee shall review 36 that report by May 1st of the year in which it is re-

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1 ceived. 2 Sec. 4. Allocation. The following funds are allocated for the fiscal years ending June 30, 1986, and June 30, 1987, for the purposes specified in this 3 4 Act and shall be segregated, apportioned and dis-5 bursed as follows: 6 7 1985-86 1986-87 8 MAINE STATE HOUSING AUTHORITY 9 10 Unallocated \$2,300,000 \$2,100,000 11 This allocation is an estimate of the 12 13 amount of revenues that will be appor-14 15 tioned to the Housing 16 Opportunities for Maine Fund under the 17 18 Maine Revised Stat-19 ute, Title 36, sec-20 tion 4641-B. This estimate is not in-21 22 tended to limit the 23 duty of the Treasurer of State to make pay-24 25 ments to that fund as provided in section 4641-B or the author-26 27 28 ity of the Maine 29 State Housing Author-30 ity to use the receipts of the fund, including those which 31 32 33 exceed the amounts 34 provided by this al-35 location, for the 36 purposes specified in the Maine Revised 37

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4 Further amend the bill by striking out all of the 5 emergency clause and the fiscal note.

STATEMENT OF FACT

7 This amendment adds a provision for a review every 2 years by the Joint Standing Committee on Taxa-8 9 tion of the revenues collected under the real estate transfer tax and dedicated to the H.O.M.E. program. 10 11 It also provides an allocation of the amount anticipated to be collected in dedicated revenues. 12
