SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A"
to S.P. 381, L.D. 1048, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify and
Improve the Laws on Education in the Unorganized Ter-
ritory."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the
Fiscal Note and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 19 Appropriation. The following funds are
appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the
purposes of this Act.

FISCAL NOTE

This bill establishes a nonlapsing contingency
fund which could tie up General Fund dollars for an
indefinite period, thus, reducing revenue available
for other programs.

The appropriation to Education in the Unorganized
Territory would be offset by an increase in General
Fund revenues transferred from the Education and Ser-
vices in the Unorganized Territory Fund.'
