The provisions of this section do not apply 25 to a passenger or operator with a physically disabling condition whose physical disability would 26 27 prevent appropriate restraint in such safety seat or safety belt, provided that the condition is 28 29 duly certified by a physician who shall state the 30 nature of the handicap, as well as the reason the 31 restraint is inappropriate. 32 STATEMENT OF FACT
