IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE
AN ACT to Make Allocations from the Maine Nuclear Emergency Planning Fund for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1986, and June 30, 1987.
Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate until after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and
Whereas, certain obligations and expenses incident to the operation of the department will become due and payable on or immediately after July 1, 1985; and
Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-

1 2	vation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,
3 4	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
5 <b>6</b> 7 8 9	Allocation of the Maine Nuclear Emergency Planning Fund. Income to the Maine Nuclear Emergency Planning Fund for the next 2 fiscal years, from July 1, 1985, to June 30, 1986, and from July 1, 1986, to June 30, 1987, shall be segregated, apportioned and disbursed as designated in the following schedule:

16	All Other \$50,000 \$50,000
17 18 19	Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect on July 1, 1985.

21 22 23 24	The purpose of this bill is to make allocations from the Maine Nuclear Emergency Planning Fund for the fiscal years ending June 30, 1986, and June 30, 1987.
