19 the Federal Expenditure Fund for the

22 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
23 lature do not become effective until 90 days after
24 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

25 Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate un-
26 til after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

27 Whereas, certain obligations and expenses will
28 become due and payable prior to June 30, 1985; and

29 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
30 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
31 the Constitution of Maine and require the following
32 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
33 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
34 therefore,

1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
2 follows:

3 Sec. 1. Additional allocation of Federal Expend-
4 iture Fund. Income to the Federal Expenditure Fund
5 for the fiscal year from July 1, 1984, to June 30,
6 1985, shall be segregated, apportioned and disbursed
7 as designated in the following schedule.

17 **Sec. 2. Adjustments to allocations.** Allocations
18 may be increased or adjusted by the State Budget Of-
19 ficer with the approval of the Governor to specifi-
20 cally cover those adjustments determined to be neces-
21 sary under any salary plan approved by the Legisla-
22 ture and those reclassifications, range changes which
23 have been approved by the Department of Personnel and
24 submitted for legislative review prior to the effec-
25 tive date of this Act.

26 **Sec. 3. Encumbered balance at year end.** At the
27 end of the fiscal year, all encumbered balances shall
28 not be carried more than once.

29 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited
30 in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when ap-
31 proved.
