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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 743, L.D. 1053, Bill, "AN ACT Making Allocations for the Administrative Expenses of the State Lottery Commission for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1986, and June 30, 1987."

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Amend the Bill in section 1 by striking out all of the last 2 lines (page 2, lines 17 and 18 in L.D.) and inserting in their place the following:

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'All Other	<u>1,228,450</u>	<u>1,285,927</u>
Total	\$1,901,684	\$1,980,050'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment increases the "All Other" allocation by \$150,000 and \$175,000 for the fiscal years ending June 30, 1986, and June 30, 1987, respectively. The increases are needed to cover additional expenses that the State Lottery Commission will incur as a participant in the Tri-State Lottery.
