19 Administrative Expenses of the State
20 Lottery Commission for the Fiscal
21 Years Ending June 30, 1986, and June
22 30, 1987.

24 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
25 lature do not become effective until 90 days after
26 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

27 Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate un-
28 til after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

29 Whereas, certain obligations and expenses inci-
30 dent to the operation of the State Lottery Commission
31 will become due and payable on or immediately after
32 July 1, 1985; and

33 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
34 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
35 the Constitution of Maine and require the following

1 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
2 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
3 therefore,

4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
5 follows:

6 **Sec. 1. Allocation of State Lottery Fund.** In or-
7 der to provide the necessary expenses for operation
8 and administration of the State Lottery Commission,
9 the following amounts, or as much as may be neces-
10 sary, are allocated from the revenues derived from
11 operations of the State Lottery Fund.

19 **Sec. 2. Allotments required.** Upon receipt of
20 allotments duly approved by the Governor based upon
21 work programs submitted to the State Budget Officer,
22 the State Controller shall authorize expenditures
23 from these allocations on the basis of these allot-
24 ments and not otherwise.

25 **Sec. 3. Legislative intent.** It is the intent of
26 the Legislature that the allocation of funds by the
27 Legislature, as provided by this Act, shall apply to
28 the operating expenses only and that these alloca-
29 tions shall be allotted and approved under the Maine
30 Revised Statutes, Title 5.

31 **Sec. 4. Adjustments to allocations.** Allocations
32 may be increased or adjusted by the State Budget Of-
33 ficer with the approval of the Governor to specifi-
34 cally cover those adjustments determined to be neces-
35 sary under any salary plan approved by the Legisla-
36 ture, and those reclassifications and range changes
37 which have been approved by the Department of Person-
