Amend the bill in section 2 in paragraph A-1, sub-
paragraph (2), division (c) by striking out all of
the last line (page 2, line 33 in L.D.) and inserting
in its place the following: 'action and was a resi-
dent of the State at the time of entering military
service, at the time of his death or at the time of
the death of an eligible dependent.'
