2 Sec. 3. 12 MRSA §6451, sub-§5, as enacted by PL 3 1977, c. 661, §5, is amended to read:

5. <u>Nonlapsing fund</u>. The Lobster Fund shall not lapse to the General Fund, but shall remain in a continuing carrying account to carry out the purposes of this section.

8 Sec. 4. 12 MRSA §6451, sub-§6 is enacted to 9 read:

6. Lobster Advisory Council. Money may be ex pended from the Lobster Fund with the advice and con sent of the Lobster Advisory Council.

STATEMENT OF FACT

14 The Lobster Advisory Council has determined that 15 allowing for greater flexibility in the use of the 16 Lobster Fund, greater efforts can be taken towards 17 improving the condition of the lobster fishery. The 18 council would have review and approval authority over 19 the use of the fund.
