21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §576, 2nd ¶, as amended by PL
24 1981, c. 517, §6, is further amended to read:

25 The State Tax Assessor shall determine the aver-
26 age stumpage value for each forest type described in
27 section 573, subsections 5 to 7, applicable in each
28 county, or in such alternative forest economic re-
29 gions as he may designate, after passage of this sub-
30 chapter and in each even-numbered year thereafter,
31 taking into consideration the prices upon sales of
32 sound standing timber of that forest type in that ar-
33 ea during the previous calendar year, and such other
34 considerations as he deems appropriate.
